Pursuant to the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permit issued by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("SWD"), we have been requested to report on the attached income and expenditure account of the Organisation's fund raising campaign "Emergency Assignment Exhibition" held during the period from 20 October 2014 to 12 November 2014 ("the Event").

**Respective responsibilities of the directors and ourselves**

The directors are responsible for preparing the attached income and expenditure account in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2, setting out the gross subscriptions raised from the Event and the expenses incurred in connection with the Event, in order to comply with the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permit issued by the SWD. This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the income and expenditure account so that it reflects the subscriptions raised and expenses incurred in connection with the Event and is free from material misstatement.

It is our responsibility to form a conclusion on the attached income and expenditure account, based on our engagement, and to report our conclusion to you.

**Basis of conclusion**

We conducted our engagement in accordance with Hong Kong Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000 "Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information" and with reference to Practice Note 850 "Reporting on Flag days and General Charitable Fund-raising Activities Covered by Public Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

**Basis of conclusion (continued)**

The work undertaken in connection with this engagement is less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Furthermore, due to the nature of cash subscriptions and expenses relating to the Event, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the income and expenditure account and the books and records of the Organisation include all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the income and expenditure account. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the income and expenditure account prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Organisation's books and records.

Our engagement included carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquiries primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary.

**Conclusion**

Based on the foregoing, we report that nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the attached income and expenditure account does not reflect, in all material respects, the gross subscriptions raised and the expenses incurred by the Organisation in respect of the Event that have been recorded in its books and records made available to us in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2.





**Notes to the income and expenditure account**

**1. General**

Section 4(17)(i) of Summary Offences Ordinance (Cap. 228) stipulates that activities relating to charitable sales and donations in public places require permits from the Social Welfare Department. Activities of "Emergency Assignment Exhibition" held during 20 October 2014 to 12 November 2014 fell under this requirement and therefore Medecins Sans Frontieres (HK) Limited obtained permit numbered 2014/275/1 on 17 October 2014.

The surplus of the Event is for supporting Medecins Sans Frontieres (HK) Limited's medical relief work by providing those people who are in need with medical care in around 70 countries.

**2. Basis of preparation**

- (a) Donation income is recognised on a cash basis.
- (b) Expenditure represents the costs incurred directly in respect of the fund-raising activities.

Expenditure is recognised on a cash basis.
